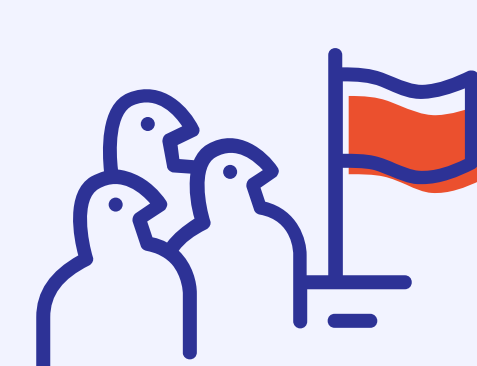
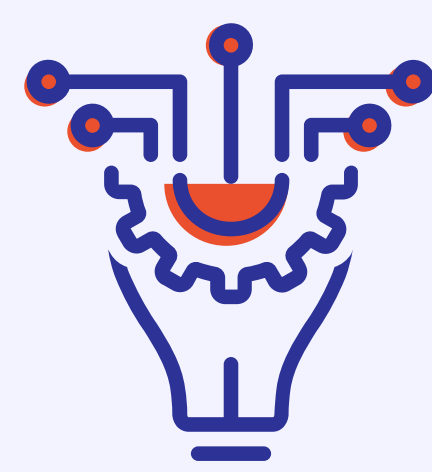

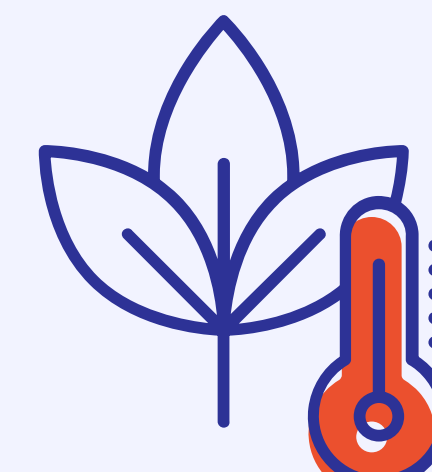
Partisanship & nationalism on the rise

Join us for **Global Ethics Day** on **October 19, 2022** and empower ethics as a force for good.



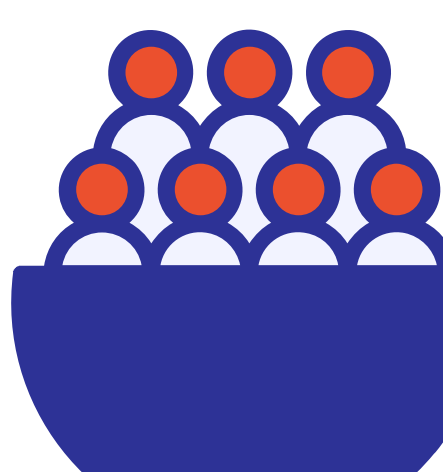
